#### GWRRRA RIDER COURSES AND SEMINARS

##### GENERAL STATEMENT

GWRRRA courses / seminars are available **only** to paid up GWRRRA Members, except as noted below, (i) as a benefit of membership; (ii) to encourage participation in the various Rider Education Program (REP) levels; and (iii) to encourage safer riding practices for Members. Non-Members registered for District / Regional Rallies may participate in training courses, provided all interested Members are first accommodated and provided sufficient additional space is available. Non-Members will be charged \$10.00 more than Members per course.

##### STATEMENT OF PROCESS

###### 1. Seminars:

As a statement of principle, Members will not be charged a fee for GWRRRA Seminars, e.g. Co-Rider, Road Captain, etc. Non-Member Rally participants will be charged \$10.00 per participant per seminar.

However, participating Members / non-Members may be asked to donate to defray legitimate **receipted** costs associated with travel for certified Seminar Instructors and for meeting space costs, if applicable.

Instructors will **not** be paid for presenting such seminars.

###### 2. Rider Courses:

Members who participate in approved GWRRRA Rider Courses, e.g. ARC, ERC, Trailering, Trike Rider, **may** be charged a maximum of \$35.00 / minimum \$20.00 per participant per course, if authorized by the District or Regional Rider Educator or Director. However, with the exception of the \$20.00 minimum, the fee charged is optional, at the discretion of the District or Regional Officer. This fee will be used to defray the cost of printing materials and any costs associated with meeting and parking lot space. Any excess revenue from these fees will be deposited in the respective Rider Education financial account.

Any legitimate **receipted** costs, in addition to the total fees collected per course, may be covered by donations from participants of the respective courses.

GWRRRA Rider Course Instructors will **not** be paid for presenting rider safety courses except, if requested, reimbursement for **receipted** travel and accommodations costs associated with attending and presenting the course(s).
